- Chassis and chassis attachments (including rear and lateral protective devices)
- Other equipment, including:
 - Warning triangle³
 - Tachograph (presence of and integrity of seals)³
 - Speed limitation device³
- Absorption coefficient.^{3,4}

4. According to UNECE regulation R24.03 or as subsequently amended, or to Directive 72/306/EEC or as subsequently amended, or to Directive 2005/78/EC or as subsequently amended; for EURO VI and positive ignition engines not required.
5. Certificate may be filled in, stamped and signed manually or electronically.
6. 12 months after the date of the test, and at the latest before the end of this same month.
