The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Poland presents its compliments to the Embassy of the Republic of Estonia in Warsaw and has the honor to propose conclusion of the following Agreement between the Republic of Poland and the Republic of Estonia on the Amendment and Termination of the Agreement between the Republic of Poland and the Republic of Estonia on the Reciprocal Promotion and Protection of Investments, signed on 6th of May 1993 in Warsaw (hereinafter "Agreement"):

- 1. The Agreement between the Republic of Poland and the Republic of Estonia on the Reciprocal Promotion and Protection of Investments, signed on 6th of May 1993 in Warsaw, is terminated.
- 2. The Parties to the Agreement agreed that in respect of investments made prior to the date when the Agreement mentioned in paragraph 1 terminates, none of its provisions remains in force.

On the understanding that the Republic of Estonia agrees with this proposal, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Poland proposes that this Note together with the reply Note constitute the Agreement between the Republic of Poland and the Republic of Estonia on the Amendment and Termination of the Agreement between the Republic of Poland and the Republic of Estonia on the Reciprocal Promotion and Protection of Investments, signed on 6th of May 1993 in Warsaw. The Agreement shall enter into force three months after the date of receiving later note confirming completion of requirements of internal laws necessary for the entry into force of this Agreement.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Poland avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy of the Republic of Estonia the assurances of its highest consideration.
